- Abstract Submission : **15 Sep. 2026**
- Intimation of acceptance of Abstract : **20 Sep. 2026**
- Submission of Full Paper– **20 Oct. 2026**
- Length of abstract –300 words (Max) Length of Full Paper–3000–4000 words (Max)
- Plagirism check report mandatory (not more then 10%)
- Reference and Citations according to MLA Handbook 7th Edition/APA as applicable.
- Papers can be presented/Written in English and Hindi language.
- Font size (English)– Times New Roman, 12 point single space
- Font size (Hindi)– Unicode/Mangal (12 point) /Kokila (16 Point)
- Send Abstract & Paper– officeparasfoundation@gmail.com
- Submitted abstracts will be evaluated by the Scientific Committee. All submissions should report original and previously unpublished research results no matter the type of research paper you are presenting. Manuscripts should meet the format set by the Conference committee and are subject to review.
- The conference will include keynote lectures, thematic paper presentations, roundtable discussions, activist testimonials, and creative sessions. Hybrid participation will be supported to ensure wider engagement.
- **Best Research Paper Award :-**The jury will select three best research papers from among the research papers presented in the International Conference based on presentation, Timeline and content. Best Research Papers will be published in APIJGS.
- **e- Certificate :-** Will be provided to all registered and full-time presented participants.
