# **ABOUT INDORE**

Indore is a historical city which used to be the capital of erstwhile Holkar Estate with a population of around 40 lacs. It is also known as "The City of Holkars". Devi Ahilya Bai Holkar was a great custodian of religion who constructed a number of temples across the estate. Indore is well known for its arts, sculpture and its unique culture. World renowned artistes like Bharat Ratna Lata Mangeshkar was born in Indore and Late Shri Kishore Kumar studied here. There are a number of artistic sculptures worth seeing in and around the city such as Rajwada, Lal Baug Palace, Kanch Mandir, etc. Indore is now known as the best education hub in central India and boasts of having both IIM and IIT in its precincts. The city of Indore shares its borders with well-developed industrial towns like Dewas and Pithampur. A number of well-known industry houses like Kirloskar, Eicher, Tata International, L&T, Mahindra, Man Force Trucks, Volvo, Cipla, Ranbaxy, Bridgestone, TCS, Infosys, Reliance, etc are pursuing business here. In view of its immense industrial potential and profuse techno-based infrastructure, Indore is recognized as "Mini Mumbai". There are some famous tourist spots at an average distance of 50-80 km. Two of the twelve Jyotirlingas, Mahakaleshwar and Omkareshwar are situated at 50 km and 85 km distance respectively from Indore. The famous historical Mandu Fort of Rani Roopmati fame is also within a distance of 65 km.

# CENTRE OF EXCELLENCE IN HAPPINESS STUDIES

Happiness is the degree to which an individual judges the overall quality of his/ her life-as-a-whole positively, or in short how well one likes the life one lives. Increasingly, collective happiness is considered to be the proper measure of social progress and the goal of public policy of any society across the globe.

The term 'Happiness Index' was coined in 1979 during an interview at Bombay airport when the then king of Bhutan, Jigme Singye Wangchuck said "We do not believe in Gross National Product. Gross National Happiness is more important."

In June 2016, The Organisation for Economic Co-operation and Development (OECD) committed itself to redefine the growth narrative to put people's well-being at the centre of governments' efforts. In February 2017, the United Arab Emirates held a full-day World Happiness meeting, as part of the World Government Summit.

Realising that the significant GDP growth rate of Madhya Pradesh in last few decades reflect only material prosperity without reflecting the happiness or contentment quotient of its citizens, the State Government decided to set up a special organization to work proactively towards the subjective wellbeing of its citizens even as the material needs continue to be addressed. Rajya Anand Sansthan (RAS) under the aegis of the Adhyatma Vibhag of the State was set up. Madhya Pradesh thus became the first Indian State to set up an organization to address Happiness of its citizens.

As a part of its commitment to serve the society through path breaking research, SVVV thought it prudent to start a Centre of Excellence in Happiness Studies in March 2018.

# GUIDELINES FOR PAPER SUBMISSION

- 1. Abstract of the paper (250 words) typed double-spaced in New Times Roman Font 12 should be sent by e-mail to anandamrit@svvv.edu.in. Only electronic submission in the form of a MS Word document as an email attachment is required to be sent on or before 15th January, 2020.
- 2. Full paper should be submitted by 31st January, 2020. Only electronic submission in the form of a MS Word document as an email attachment is required to be sent to the abovementioned email address.
- 3. The full paper should include Title of the Paper (Bold), name(s) of Author(s), Affiliation(s), postal & email address and phone numbers, Abstract (Italics), 4 to 6 Keywords (Bold), main paper appropriately paragraphed (maximum 4000 words), and References in APA style. The entire document should be typed double-spaced in Times New Roman (12) font.
- 4. The authors are required to check originality of their work before sending. Paper may be rejected if the work is found plagiarized. As such ownership of originality will be with the authors.
- 5. Acceptance of paper will be notified within a week of receipt.
- 6. Selected papers, on recommendation of the Reviewers, may be published in a book bearing a ISBN or included in the Journal of the University.
