

The template of full paper will be shared along with the acceptance of abstract, References should include in case of paper/article- Name of Author(s), Year of Publication, Title of paper/Article, Name of Journal, Volume (Number) and Page Number(s). In case of book itshould include- Name of Author(s), Year of Publication. Title of book, Place of Publication, Name of publisher and Page Number(s). The authors are required to check originality of their work before sending. The sole responsibility of violating plagiarism rules will be of the authors. Selected Paper, on recommendation of reviewers, will be published in a book bearing a ISBN




