THEORY

UNIT I

Symptoms, cause and management of major diseases of following crops:

Rice: Blast, Bacterial blight; Maize: Downy mildew, leaf spots; Groundnut: early and late leaf spots; Soybean: Rhizoctonia blight, bacterial spot, seed and seedling rot and mosaic; Pigeonpea: wilt and sterility mosaic; Guava: wilt and anthracnose

<u>UNIT II</u>

Symptoms, cause and management of major diseases of following crops:

Wheat: Rusts, loose smut, karnal bunt, powdery mildew, alternaria blight; Gram: wilt, grey mould and Ascochyta blight; Mango: anthracnose, malformation, bacterial blight and powdery mildew; Citrus: canker and gummosis

UNIT III

Symptoms, cause and management of major diseases of following crops:

Black & Green gram: Cercospora leaf spot, anthracnose and yellow mosaic; Pea: downy mildew,

powdery mildew and rust; Cucurbits: downy mildew, powdery mildew, wilt Cotton: anthracnose, vascular wilt, and black arm

UNIT IV

Symptoms, cause and management of major diseases of following crops:

Cruciferous vegetables: Alternaria leaf spot and black rot; Brinjal: Phomopsis blight and fruit rot and Sclerotinia blight; Chilli: anthracnose and fruit rot, wilt and leaf curl Onion: purple blotch; Beans: anthracnose and bacterial blight

UNIT V

Symptoms, cause and management of major diseases of following crops:

Tomato: damping off, wilt, early and late blight, buck eye rot, leaf curl and mosaic; Okra: Yellow Vein Mosaic;; Coriander: stem gall; Marigold: Botrytis blight; Rose: dieback, powdery mildew and black leaf spot.
